Privacy Policy Overview

- This Privacy Policy explains how DMSG treats personal information that the company collects when you visit our site, and when you use our services.
- This policy does not apply to any partners or other companies that are not owned or controlled by DMSG.

Information Collection and Use

- DMSG does not automatically gather any information from you. Information is only obtained if you supply it to us.
- Information provided to DMSG is only used for DMSG's internal purposes including contacting you and answering your queries.
- DMSG uses software that receives and records the Internet protocol IP addresses. DMSG will not link these addresses with the identity of the individuals visiting its site except in cases of abuse of its site.
- DMSG does not use "cookies" to track our visitors.

Information Sharing and Disclosure

- Visitor Information is treated by DMSG as confidential information. Visitor Information will not be disclosed to anyone without consent except as required by law, or in accordance with this privacy statement or as permitted pursuant to the Canadian Personal Information Protection and Electronic Documents Act, 2000, c.5 ("PIPEDA") http://www.privcom.gc.ca/legislation/02_06_01_01_e.asp.
- DMSG will not share personally identifiable information about you to other companies or people unless:
 - We have your consent to share this information;
 - It is necessary in order to provide the product or service you have requested; under such circumstances, our business partners operate under confidentiality agreements which restrict their use and dissemination of your personal information. Their use of your personal information is only in support of the assistance we have requested from them on your behalf.

- We reasonably believe it is necessary to share information in order to investigate, prevent, or take action regarding illegal activities, situations involving potential threats to the physical safety of any person, or as otherwise required or permitted by law;
 - We respond to warrants, subpoenas, court orders or legal process or to establish or exercise our legal rights or defend against legal claims.
